## Third-Party Sources Reporting That Slotkin Signed An NDA Covering The Gotion Project

- 1.) <u>Detroit News</u>: "To be part of those conversations, MEDC required Congresswoman Slotkin and members of our staff to sign an NDA,' said Austin Cook, a spokesman for Slotkin"
- 2.) Fox News: "Slotkin's office confirmed to The Detroit News earlier this year that the Michigan lawmaker and her deputy legislative director Austin Girelli signed NDAs...Following publication of this report, Cook confirmed Slotkin signed the NDA, but declined to comment further."
