Only seven of Tammy Baldwin’s 453 introduced bills have become law; for one stretching lasting more than ten years, not a single Baldwin-sponsored bill was signed into law as standalone legislation.

- Since entering the House during the 106th Congress, Baldwin has introduced 453 bills, only seven of which have become law.
